



Developing a deeper connection through the Quran

Remembrance (Dhikr)

The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) said, "Allah says: 'I am as My servant thinks I am. I am with him when he makes mention of Me. If he makes mention of Me to himself, I make mention of him to Myself; and if he makes mention of Me in an assembly, I make mention of him in an assembly better than it'" (Sahih Al-Bukhari).



Repentance



Purifies the heart and enables us to maintain a strong connection with Allah.

The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) said, "When a servant of Allah sins, a black spot appears on his heart. If he repents, seeks forgiveness, and abandons the sin, his heart is cleansed. But if he continues to sin, the blackness increases until it overwhelms his heart"

(Sunan Ibn Majah).

By actively engaging in acts of obedience and doing good deeds we strengthen our connection with Allah.

"And those who strive for Us – We will surely guide them to Our ways. And indeed, Allah is with the doers of good" (Quran 29:69).




Strengthens the connection with Allah Almighty

"And when My servants ask you concerning Me, indeed I am near. I respond to the invocation of the supplicant when he calls upon Me" (Quran 2:186)


